

How to sign up for the correct CITI course for IRB Applications




Go to www.citiprogram.org and click on the "Register" button located in the top right-hand corner

*If you have already registered with CITI, skip to page 8.

Select Your Organization Affiliation

- UWF students, faculty and staff will select "University of West Florida" from the drop down box.
- Check off the two boxes underneath. Do not register as an Independent Learner, or you will be charged.
- Click the "Continue to Create your CITI Program Username/ Password button" to continue.



Complete the Registration Steps

Step 2: Creating login credentials using your UWF email address.

Step 3: Create a username and password.

Step 4: Country of Residence.

Step 5: Continuing Education Credit preferences

Step 6: Enter the required information. Some information is voluntary.

Step 7: Select Curriculum

Selecting Curriculum: Questions 2-7

- 2. <u>Good Clinical Practices:</u> Only required if you will be working in a clinical trial. *If not applicable, skip this question.*
- 3. <u>Information Privacy Security</u>: Only required if you will be accessing protected health information. *If not applicable, skip this question.*
- 4. <u>Responsible Conduct of Research</u>: Only required for certain grants. See the <u>RCR website</u> for more information. *If not applicable, skip this question*.

Selecting Curriculum: Questions 5-7

- 5. <u>Responsible Conduct of Research Refresher</u>. Same as above. If not applicable, skip this question.
- 6. <u>Conflicts of Interest</u>: Only required for certain grants. See the <u>FCOI</u> <u>website</u> for more information. If not applicable, select "No"
- 7. <u>Laboratory Animal Research</u>- Only required for IACUC applications. *If* not applicable, skip this question.
