

NOTICE OF PROPOSED REPEAL OF REGULATION

University of West Florida

November 13, 2007

REGULATION TITLE: UWF/REG 3.022 Student Publications

PURPOSE AND EFFECT: It is proposed to repeal this regulation because the content is covered by University policy.

AUTHORITY FOR REGULATION: Article IX, Florida Constitution, Board of Governors Resolutions dated January 7, 2003, Board of Governors Regulation Development Procedure 7/21/05.

THE FULL TEXT OF THE REGULATION TO BE REPEALED IS SET FORTH BELOW:

University of West Florida Regulations

UWF/REG-3.022 Student Publications.

(1) Definition – Student publications comprise the printed media authorized by the President as campus-wide university publications produced by students. The one such authorized student publication is the VOYAGER.

(2) Purpose – The University considers the VOYAGER a valuable aid in establishing and maintaining an atmosphere of free

and responsible discussion and of intellectual exploration on the campus. In order to maintain integrity of purpose as vehicles for

free inquiry and expression in an academic community, the VOYAGER is responsible for observance of the canons of responsible

journalism, such as the avoidance of libel, indecency, undocumented allegations, attacks on personal integrity, and the techniques

of harassment.

(3) Authority – The University President, as publisher, has final authority and responsibility in matters relating to the VOYAGER.

(a) The Vice President for Student Affairs is responsible to the President for the general administration of the VOYAGER and shall recommend to the President the appointment of an Advisor.

(b) The VOYAGER advisor shall be responsible for the professional instruction and guidance, for recommending appointment of student editors, and for administering fiscal affairs of the VOYAGER.
