

UWF Guardian mobile safety app

Help is on the way with a push of a button, you can directly connect to 911 or campus police in an emergency and can be tracked by GPS.

Users can send alerts directly through the app to

- initiate 2-way chats with campus police,
- share their location,
- make 1-button emergency calls to numbers user inputs,
- use timers to invite people to monitor them when they feel unsafe,
- view a directory of resource phone numbers, and
- access links to UWF's safety procedures.

ARGO Safety Escorts

Available 24 hours. Easy as 1-2-3!

- Call UWF Police Department at 850.474.2415 to request a Safety Escort
- Dispatcher will ask for your current location, destination on campus and first name
- A student safety escort or uniform police officer will escort you to any location on campus.



Operation Identification

The UWFPD will assist you in engraving a number or symbol onto your valuables such as stereos, cameras, computers etc. Then you place an Operation I.D sticker on the exterior door and windows or residence hall doors warning housebreakers that all valuables on premises are marked for easy identification. Print and fill out the Operation I.D. Form, submit it in person or email to crimeprevention@uwf.edu Stop by or call the UWF Police department to obtain a Registration Sticker.



UWF Emergency Mobile Alert

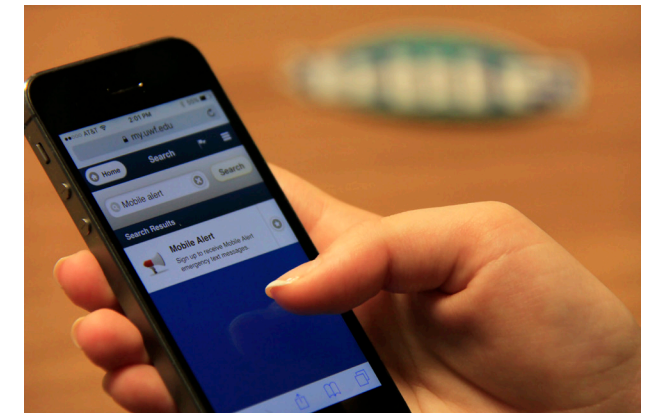
Students, faculty and staff accessing Mobile Alert for the first time must first log in to MyUWF and search for “Contact and Privacy Information,” then activate emergency messages through the “Text Notifications” tab.

Users may also add a cell phone number for text message notifications and email addresses and cell phone numbers for outside parties, such as parents, spouses and other contacts. Mobile Alert also supports text message notifications for international cell phone numbers. International text alerts are one-way, i.e. recipients cannot reply to a text message sent to an international number.

In order to add additional contacts and information to Mobile Alert, log in to MyUWF and search for Mobile Alert or visit uwf.edu/mobilealert.

To add international phone numbers, enter a plus sign (+) followed by the country code, any special codes required by the country, followed by the number, with no punctuation or spaces other than the plus sign.

This system is only utilized in the event that UWF needs to communicate information regarding an emergency or situation.



Blue Lights Emergency Assistance

If you are threatened, see anything suspicious or require police assistance quickly, open the box and push the emergency button.
