



MBA Program Technological Requirements

The decision to enter the Master of Business Administration Program is typically not taken lightly, nor should a student's decision about his/her computer equipment for the program. In order to assist you in the assessment of your technological readiness for the MBA classes, the following list is provided:

I. Internet Connectivity

Many of the MBA courses use the UWF web-based course management platform called eLearning (<http://elearning.uwf.edu>) to enhance the delivery of the curriculum. It is strongly recommended that students use a broadband (DSL or cable) type Internet connection because of the interactive materials and technologies. This type of connection will allow less time waiting for files to open or download.

II. Computer Hardware

The UWF minimum desktop computer hardware standards are the following specifications:

Monitor:	17" LCD Flat Panel Preferred
Form Factor:	Small, Space Saver or All-in-One
Networking:	Integrated 10/100 Ethernet NIC
Mouse:	USB optical
Operating System:	Windows 7 Professional, NTFS file system.

The UWF minimum software standards are the following specifications:
