Subject: Procedure for Inspecting Ladders

Purpose and Scope: To ensure that personnel have the knowledge to properly inspect ladders for safe use.

Procedures: Ladders should be inspected before each use.

- 1. Observe general condition. Is the ladder clean and dry, free from oil, mud, etc.?
- 2. Visually inspect the ladder for cracks.
- 3. Check for missing, bent, or loose rungs.
- 4. Ladders should never be painted, as this could hide dangerous defects.
- 5. Ensure no steps are damaged or bent.
- 6. Check footpads and ensure they are clean and securely fastened. All ladders should have slip-resistant rubber or plastic feet.
- 7. If a ladder is damaged, notify supervisor to remove from service and replace.
