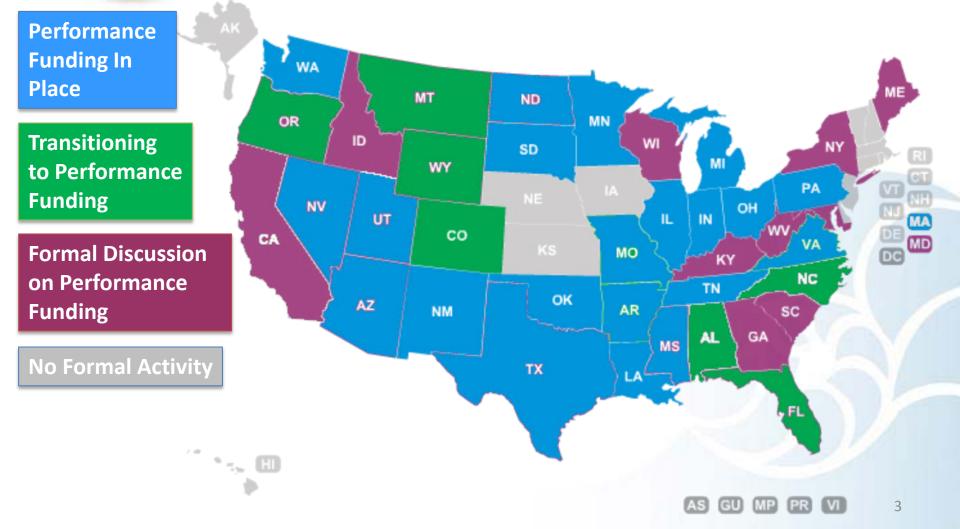
PERFORMANCE BASED FUNDING

- Measures and funds outcomes not inputs (enrollment)

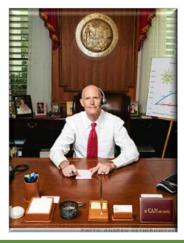
Sent Back to BOG to Implement Law





STATE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM of FLORIDA Board of Governors

Makes Proposal to Legislature



Approves bill and it becomes a law or he vetoes bill



Bills passed by both houses of the Legislature are sent to Governor for his approval



Step 1

Reviews, Researches, Develops Bill

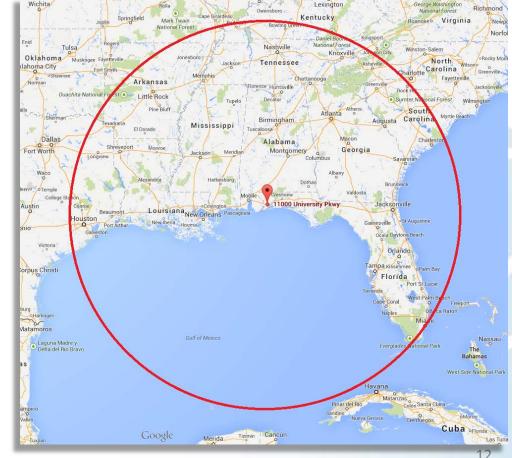

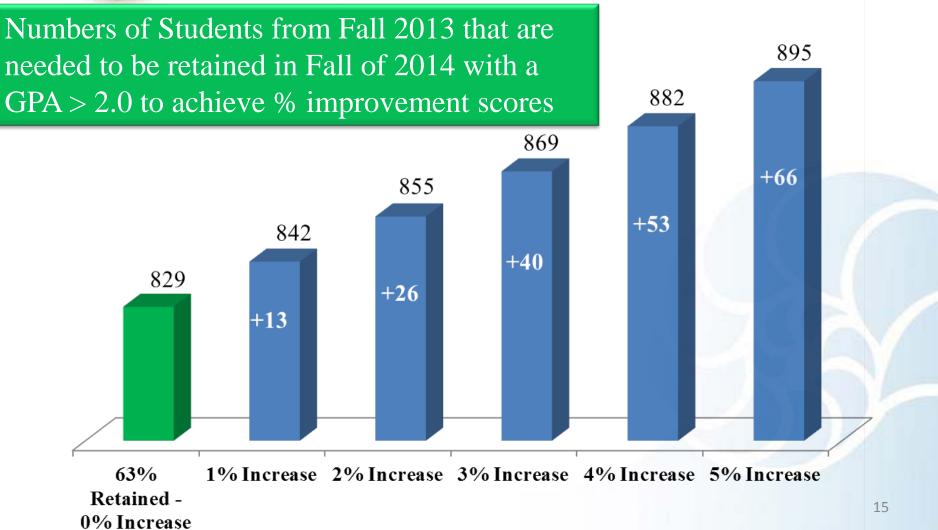
