

Degree Requirements for a Bachelor of Science in Nursing

Completion of all academic requirements for a bachelor's degree from UWF as stated in the UWF catalog, excluding upper division nursing courses and credit hour requirements

- **Students must earn a grade of “C” or better in all common course prerequisite and nursing courses. A minimum GPA of 2.75 is required for consideration for acceptance into the upper division nursing courses.**
- **Completion of all statewide common course prerequisites with grade of “C” or better prior to admission to upper division nursing program:**
 - BSC 1085/L Anatomy and Physiology I with Lab
 - BSC 1086/L Anatomy and Physiology II with Lab
 - CHM 1032/L Fundamentals of General Chemistry with Lab
 - DEP 2004 Human Development Across the Life Span
 - HSC 2577 Principles of Nutrition
 - MCB 1000/L Fundamentals of Microbiology with Lab
 - PSY 2012 General Psychology
 - STA 2023 Elements of Statistics
 - SYG 2000 Introduction to Sociology
- **The following courses are not required, but are strongly recommended as elective courses for nursing students:**
 - Fundamentals of Organic and Biochemistry with Lab (CHM 2200/L)
 - Pathophysiology (HSC 3550)
- **Acceptance into upper division nursing program and completion of upper division nursing core courses with grade of “C” or better:**
