

DUAL MAJOR DESIGNATION

Undergraduate Degree-seeking Students Only

Students should complete this form and return it to the Office of the Registrar. This form should be used for the initial designation and subsequent changes of dual majors. Please Note: You will receive written confirmation or denial.

1. Students may elect to earn a bachelor's degree with two majors effective Fall Semester 1998. The two selected majors may not be separate specializations within the same program (e.g., Public Relations and Journalism).
2. You must select one major as your primary major. Only one diploma will be awarded. The degree awarded (B.S., B.A., etc.) will be the degree associated with the primary major. Upon completion of all course work, both departments must certify that you have met all graduation requirements for a degree in that major. Upon completion of the degree, both majors will be indicated on the transcript.
3. The Catalog Year will be determined based on policies listed in the Catalog. The Catalog Year for both majors must be the same.
4. To cancel a dual major designation, you must submit a "Change of Major" form to the Registrar's Office. Major change will be effective the semester the form is received in the Registrar's Office if currently enrolled.
