ALABAMA DIFFERENTIAL OUT-OF-STATE TUITION PLAN**

Semester for which residency change is requested: _____

The University of West Florida has been authorized to offer residents of Alabama a special out-of-state tuition rate.

An Alabama resident must be a U.S. citizen, permanent resident alien, or legal alien granted indefinite stay by INS and meet one of the following requirements to qualify for differential out-of-state tuition:

- A. Be an independent person or a dependent of a person who has established and maintained legal ties to Alabama for the previous 12 months as evidenced by a combination of a driver's license, vehicle registration, voter registration, Declaration of Domicile, etc.
- OR**
- B. Active duty personnel of the Armed Forces whose state of legal residence or location of active duty station is in Alabama, or spouse, or dependent children.

I meet the Alabama residency requirements to qualify for differential out-of-state tuition fees based on the following criteria:

- _____ A. I am an independent person (a person who provides more than 50% of his/her own support as defined by the Internal Revenue Service) who has established and maintained legal ties to Alabama. [Required: Copy of current Alabama driver's license and vehicle registration or voter registration];
- OR**
- _____ B. I am a dependent person (a person for whom 50% or more of his/her support is provided by another as defined by the Internal Revenue Service) whose parent or legal guardian has established and maintained legal ties to Alabama. [Required: Copy of parent/legal guardian's current Alabama driver's license and vehicle registration or voter registration; if legal guardian, proof of court-appointed legal guardianship is also required];
- OR**
- _____ C. I am a member of the armed services of the United States and I am stationed in Alabama on active military duty pursuant to military orders **OR** whose state of legal residence is Alabama, or I am a member's spouse or dependent child. [Required: Copy of military orders or DD-2058 (showing state of legal residence); for spouse, also provide marriage certificate].

Documents supporting the establishment of legal Alabama residence must be dated, issued, or filed 12 months before the first day of classes of the term for which the Alabama resident classification is sought. All documentation is subject to verification. Additional documentation other than what is required above may be requested in some cases.
