## Undergraduate Degree-seeking Students Only

Students should complete this form and return it to the University Advising Center. This form should be used for the initial designation and subsequent changes of dual majors. Please Note: You will receive written confirmation or denial.

1. Students may elect to earn a bachelor’s degree with two majors effective Fall Semester 1998. The two selected majors may not be separate specializations within the same program (e.g., Public Relations and Journalism).
2. You must select one major as your primary major. Only one diploma will be awarded. The degree awarded (B.S., B.A., etc.) will be the degree associated with the primary major. Upon completion of all course work, both departments must certify that you have met all graduation requirements for a degree in that major. Upon completion of the degree, both majors will be indicated on the transcript.
3. The Catalog Year will be determined based on policies listed in the Catalog. The Catalog Year for both majors must be the same.
4. To cancel a dual major designation, you must submit a Major/Minor Change form to the University Advising Center. The major change will be effective the semester the form is received in the University Advising Center if currently enrolled.
