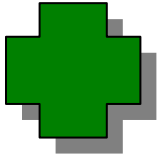

OSHA 10-hour Construction Course

Course Dates/Hours: February 3rd from 8 AM – 5 PM and continuing on February 4th from 8 AM – Noon

Course Location: Payne Building, Sacred Heart Hospital --5149 N. 9th Avenue, Suite 255, Pensacola, FL

Course Fees: Members \$125 / Nonmembers \$150

Objectives: This course will introduce the student to the construction safety and health standards of the Occupational Health and Safety Administration (OSHA). Students attending the entire course will receive their "OSHA 10 hour card" by mail approximately 2 weeks after the course concludes. Upon completion, the student will be able to:

- State the purpose of the OSH Act and list the functions of OSHA
- List the OSHA inspection priorities and describe the inspection process
- Describe the rights and responsibilities of employers & employees under the OSH Act
- Understand the requirements for compliance with various construction standards

Description: The 10-hour program is intended to provide a variety of training on Construction safety and health for construction workers, supervisors, and others involved in construction activities> It emphasizes hazard identification, avoidance, control and prevention, not OSHA standards. The topics covered include

- Intro to OSHA
- Electrical (Subpart K)
- Fall Protection
- Health Standards in Construction (Subpart D)
- Hazard Communication (Subpart D)
- *Personal Protective and Lifesaving Equipment (Subpart E)
- *Materials Handling, Storage, Use and Disposal (Subpart E)
- *Hand and Power Tools (Subpart I)
- *Scaffolds (Subpart L)
- *Cranes, Derricks, Hoists, Elevators, and Conveyers (Subpart N)
- *Excavations (Subpart P)
- *Stairways and Ladders (Subpart X)
- *These topics are electives and may be expanded or eliminated based on the needs of the class.
