

Topic: UCSA Sidewalk Chalking
Updated: March 13, 2009

Sidewalk chalking is permitted in order to promote the activities and events sponsored by student organizations and departments formally associated with the University of West Florida. Chalking by individuals or outside groups is not permitted.

Student organizations and departments may chalk (with water soluble chalk) on concrete outdoor sidewalks immediately adjacent to the University Commons. Chalking is not permitted on any vertical surfaces (entrances walkways and steps), under any overhang or roof where rain can't wash it away, or on buildings, walls or on any surfaces that are brick or tiled.

Offenders will be asked to remove chalk in unauthorized areas or will be charged the cost of removal.
