All IFC, NPC, or NPHC affiliated chapters in good standing are eligible. Chapters who are not in good standing with the Office of Greek Affairs, or who have been found responsible for a judicial violation are not eligible for the Greek Excellence Awards.

Instructions for applying for Greek Excellence Awards:

√ Please provide a 1-3 page summary of your chapter's activities in the areas of scholarship, leadership, service and brotherhood/sisterhood for the past year.

√ The selection committee will review your 1-3 page summary when determining the "best-fit" recipient for each award.

√ Chapters are encouraged to include up to 3 pages of supporting documents such as press clippings, advertisements, letters of recommendation etc. if appropriate

√ Please attach a cover page which includes the following information:

- Organization Name
- President
- Advisor
- Number of Current Members
- Estimated Annual Budget

Following each value is a list of types of criteria that we will use in evaluating your application. It is not a checklist of criteria, so please be creative and apply.

1) Scholarship

- Innovative scholarship programming
- Overall GPA or improvement in GPA over time
- Faculty and staff involvement in chapter

2) Philanthropy and Service

- Innovation in philanthropy execution
- Widest influence in the community
- Encouragement of civic responsibility among members and Greek community

3) Leadership

- Sets strong example which other chapters strive to follow
- Strong and dedicated executive board
- Development of leadership skills within the chapter and its members

4) Brotherhood/Sisterhood

- Interaction with campus and community organizations
- Chapter with remarkable brotherhood/sisterhood
- Commitment to group development, diversity, and community
