

Cybersecurity Management, Graduate Certificate

This certificate teaches students to develop policies and procedures that ensure the safety of an organization's information assets without harming the productivity of the organization. Students will perform risk assessment to identify potential threats and design mitigation plans and identify the ethical dilemmas that occur in the context of cybersecurity. Conceptual and technical aspects of cybersecurity management solutions are discussed including the design, development and building of an information security management solution.
