- Construct challenging lessons and convey high expectations through clear oral and written communication.
- Identify and integrate current information and technologies that enhance learning through student interactions.

### **Integrity/Values**

- Organize and adapt the learning environment based on diversity of students.
- Implement knowledge and skills gained from professional development opportunities into the teaching and learning process.

## **Assessment of Student Learning Outcomes**

Student learning will be assessed through academic performance on exams, written assignments, lesson plans, instructional presentations and projects.
