Identify veterans with appropriate experience and expertise and provide them with relevant pedagogical and technical knowledge and skills to teach in designated and candidate CAE-C institutions

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Project highlights:

- Five Veterans per year with appropriate experience and expertise, will be taught Cybersecurity courses for free
- They will be reskilled and encourage to enroll in UWF's M.S. in Cybersecurity or M.S. in Information Technology
- Pathways for the selected veterans will provide them with required knowledge, skills, and abilities giving the Veteran the option to be brought into UWF's adjunct pool to teach lower-level courses in Cybersecurity and Information Technology
- Five sample courses that will be offered at no cost. (courses will be adjusted to meet the needs of the Veteran):
 - CompTIA Security+ certification
 - Network Defense
 - Threat Intelligence
 - Risk Management/Incident Response
 - Pedagogical Best Practices
- Courses will be taught as per schedule below:
 - Year 1: August 2021 – December 2021
 - Year 2: August 2022 – December 2022
