HSI for Rising Seniors focuses on College Readiness, while HSI for Rising Juniors focuses on Identity. Participants will gain confidence in their ability to be successful in college and an understanding of the Kugelman Honors Program's values, benefits, and opportunities. Students will develop skills in interdisciplinary thinking, professional and productive communication, personal goal-setting, critical thinking, meaningful reflection, note-taking, project management, and much more!

HSI 2024 Registration Deadlines and Details

Registration for HSI 2024:

- Deadline: May 1, 2024, by 5:00 PM.
- Capacity: Limited to 40 participants, with 20 slots each for rising seniors and juniors.
- **Procedure**: Submit your registration via the provided link before the deadline. If the program reaches its capacity before the deadline, a waitlist option will be implemented.

Cancellation

All cancellation requests must be submitted via email. Please send your cancellation request to <u>continuinged@uwf.edu</u>.

Cancellation Procedure:

- Cancellation requests received at least six weeks prior to the institute's start date of the program: Full refund.
- Cancellation requests received less than six weeks but at least three weeks prior to the institute's start date: Refund of 50%.
- Cancellation requests received less than three weeks prior to the institute's start date or "no show": No refund.

Note: Refunds will be issued to the individual/organization who made the original payment.





Check-in

• Check-in: Monday, June 3, 2023, from 8:30-10:00 AM. in Pace Hall, Building 930, First Floor Lounge.

Required items for check-in:

- Parents and guardians must present a valid government-issued ID
- Students must present a student ID or government-issued ID (if the student does not have an ID, a parent or guardian's ID can be substituted)
- Health insurance card
- "Must-Haves" items are located on the packing list in the preparatory guide

Parking:

- Parents and guardians are allowed to park in front of Pace Hall for up to 30 minutes for check-in and check-out only.
- Visitor permits are available free of charge at the Visitors Center (Building 81) and Parking Services (Building 20W, Room 151) during weekdays from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.



















Required for Check-in

- ID- Students and Parents/Guardians
- Health Insurance Card

Must-Haves

- Prescriptions (if any)
- Personal Care

 - Pillow
- Clothing and Footwear
 - Closed-toe shoes
 - Clothing suitable for summer in Florida (include a light jacket or sweatshirt for indoor temperature variations)
 - Pajamas
- Accessories and Miscellaneous
 - Reusable water bottle
 - Money (enough for two meals and two snacks for outings)

Will Probably Want

- Sealed snacks (especially if you have special dietary needs)
- Other shoes (slippers, house shoes)
- Phone and charger
- Extra money
