Whereas Peggy de Villiers transferred to the University of West Florida in 2013; and

Whereas Peggy de Villiers competed on the University of West Florida's inaugural Women's Swim and Dive team during the 2013-2014 academic year; and

Whereas Peggy de Villiers has set University of West Florida School records for the 200-yard freestyle, 100-yard freestyle, 50-yard freestyle, and the 100-yard butterfly; and

Whereas Peggy de Villiers was selected for both the 2013-2014 and 2014-2015 All-NSISC teams; and

Whereas Peggy de Villiers received five All-America Honorable Mentions in the 2014-2015 academic year and three All-America Honorable Mentions in the 2013-2014 academic year by the College Swimming Coaches Association of America; and

Whereas Peggy de Villiers competed in the 4th World Deaf Swimming Championship (WDSC) representing South Africa; and

Whereas Peggy de Villiers set the WDSC world record for the 50-meter butterfly on August 17, 2015 and the 100-meter butterfly on August 22, 2015.
