Legislative Intent: In order to ensure that the University of West Florida is represented as accurately as possible, this bill ensures that only students who have attended a university for at least two semesters will be able to serve in SGA, excluding the freshman committee. Students who have completed two semesters at a University will 1) have a university GPA in accordance with the eligibility requirements and 2 ) will have a better understanding of the needs of a university. This will also ensure that freshman committee stays relevant. The wording of "two semesters or more" ensures that students applying will not use college credit earned in high school as a loophole as well as ensures that students that are enrolled part time or that are transfer students will be able to serve.

## TITLE V: ADDENDUMS

500.2

1. Eligibility and Procedure for Filing
A. To be eligible to seek and hold a position in the Student Government Association, students must be enrolled at the University of West Florida, and in accordance with the university policy to hold a leadership position, as well as, in good standing with the university conduct policy. University policy states that all candidates running for an SGA position must hold at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average. Students must have attended a university for at least two semesters by the start date of their term, with the exclusion of the freshman committee. If a person is ineligible at the time of filing, eligibility must be established by the filing deadline or the student's application will be rejected.
