WHEREAS, according to the 2019 #RealCollege National Survey Report, at the time of surveying, roughly 86,000 students were food insecure across the nation; and


WHEREAS, to help combat student food insecurity, the Argo Pantry was created to provide food, hygiene products and other vital aid to those in need, becoming a program so critical that its usage more than doubled in the last year alone; and

WHEREAS, UWF Parking & Transportation Services collaborated with Student Body President Zenani Johnson to create a program to support the Argo Pantry; and

WHEREAS, this program was titled and advertised as "Food for Fines", and allowed students to turn in canned goods to have their parking fines waived, coming in at a grand total of more than \$5,000 worth of fines waived.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that we commend the outstanding work that UWF Parking & Transportation Services and UWF Business & Auxiliary Services did to help combat student food insecurity, and we look forward to our continued partnership with their office on this and other problems that students face.
