# Free-Tuition Eligibility

#### **ARGO 30 GUARANTEE**

UWF covers up to 30 credit hours (fall and spring) of tuition and mandatory fees that are not covered by grants or scholarships for new, qualifying undergraduate students who are Florida residents, full-time Pell Grant eligible, and working toward their first undergraduate degree. In other words, students who qualify pay no out-of-pocket costs for tuition and mandatory fees.
