TRANSFER TO FIU TODAY!

Associate in Arts (AA) Degree Graduates

- Applicants from a Florida State College or State University will be considered for admission without restriction except for published limited access programs within the University
- We encourage all transfer applicants to apply for admission at least one semester prior to the term they wish to enroll
- Students transferring from Independent Florida and Out-of-State colleges must have maintained a minimum 2.0 GPA using a 4.0 scale and be in good academic standing at their prior institution
- We recommend submitting your high school transcript to satisfy the foreign language requirement

Transfers with 60 or more credits

- Official transcripts from all previous post-secondary institutions must be forwarded to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions
- Successful completion of prerequisites for intended major Visit mymajor.fiu.edu for details
- Coursework must be completed at an institution accredited as degree-granting by a regional accrediting body or accredited as degree-granting by a national accrediting agency recognized by the U.S. Department of Education
- Must have a 2.0 GPA using a 4.0 scale and be in good standing at their prior institution

Note: Satisfying minimum requirements does not guarantee admission to FIU or specific majors. For additional information on transfer requirements, visit admissions.fiu.edu.

Apply for admission at go.fiu.edu/fiuapply and submit the following:

- Non-refundable \$30 application fee
- Official college transcripts from each institution you've attended. (You should submit a partial transcript for an initial application review and a final transcript once all college coursework is complete and degree is posted). FIU's mailing address is **P.O. Box 659003 Miami, FL 33265-9003**.
- Visit my.fiu.edu to view your To-Do list and submit any outstanding documents.
- **Note:** total application process may take 4-6 weeks
