WHO CAN APPLY TO TRANSFER?

Admission criteria varies based upon the total number of transferable semester hours of college coursework you will have completed by the time you enroll at UCF. Each category below specifies admission requirements.

TRANSFERABLE HOURS*

- 1. Minimally meet the first-year student high school unit, GPA and SAT or ACT admission requirements
- 2. Have a competitive overall college GPA
- 3. Be in good academic standing (minimum 2.0 GPA*) at the last institution attended

BETWEEN

30-59

TRANSFERABLE HOURS

- 1. Minimally have completed a college-level English composition and Mathematics course with a grade of "C" or better
- 2. Demonstrated competency in a foreign language (or ASL) equivalent to the 2nd high school or college level.
- 3. Have a competitive overall college GPA
- 4. Be in good academic standing (minimum 2.0 GPA*) at the last institution attended

TRANSFER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

The Office of Undergraduate Admissions offers several types of scholarships for transfer students. Each of the awards is a total value of \$2,000 distributed over 4 undergraduate semesters. Students earning an AA degree from a Florida public community/state college with a 3.5 or greater cumulative GPA starting in the fall semester can submit a scholarship application.
