APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

LOWER LEVEL TRANSFER – 12-29 TRANSFERABLE CREDIT HOURS*

- Minimum 2.50 high school GPA (recalculated by UNF and weighted)
- Minimum overall 2.25 post-secondary college GPA
- Minimum 2.00 GPA at last institution attended
- Must have either SAT, ACT or CLT on file
- Course completion rate (CR) equal to or greater than 67%

MID-LEVEL TRANSFER - 30-59 TRANSFERABLE CREDIT HOURS*

- · Minimum overall 2.25 post-secondary college GPA
- Minimum 2.00 GPA at last institution attended
- Course completion rate (CR) equal to or greater than 67%
- Must have one of the following:
 - Minimum 2.50 high school GPA (recalculated by UNF and weighted) and SAT, ACT or CLT test scores on file, or
 - Completion of both a college-level English (composition) and math course (intermediate algebra or higher) with a C or better in both

UPPER LEVEL TRANSFER – 60+ TRANSFERABLE CREDIT HOURS*

- · Must have one of the following:
 - Minimum overall 2.00 post-secondary college GPA if transferring from a Florida College System (FCS) or State University System (SUS) institution with an A.A. degree
 - Minimum overall 2.25 post-secondary college GPA if transferring without an FCS or SUS A.A. degree
- Minimum 2.00 GPA at last institution attended
- Course completion rate (CR) equal to or greater than 67%
