### Course Description

This exercise is intended to improve participant's awareness of and their response to phishing incidents through cyber threat-based scenarios. This exercise works best with a combination of individuals from different roles working together. Participants will work in groups to discuss scenarios and plan responses to phishing attempts. There will be a discussion of the indications of phishing and ways to verify validity. The exercise closes with a discussion of case studies of actual cybersecurity incidents, how the attacked organizations responded, and lessons learned from the incidents.
