Course Description

As cyberattacks are growing in numbers, many of the attacks are exploiting code level vulnerabilities. Further, the increased reliance on software outsourced from vendors and third parties are putting organizations and stakeholders more vulnerable to attacks. This course will cover the basics of secure application development principles. It will focus on OWASP top 10 bugs that can be found widely in open or closed source system, followed by some of the common tools that are available to detect them early. This course uses a combination of lectures, discussions, and hands-on activities in a synchronous (online) modality via zoom.
