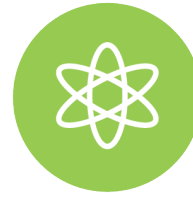

Paid Internships

Students are connected with summer internship opportunities and receive a starting stipend of \$1250.

STEM Master Mentor

Each student is paired with a mentor. These science and math educators are trained to facilitate content-focused coaching during field experiences.

Field Experiences

Several courses incorporate field experiences in both formal and informal educational settings to prepare students for designing and delivering inquiry-based science and math lessons.

Professional Certification Pathway for Grades 6 - 12

Students who graduate from the UWF-Teach program track will hold professional teaching certification for grades 6 - 12 upon graduation from UWF.

NOYCE SCHOLARS

Scholarship recipients are awarded up to **\$20,500 per year**

Eighteen STEM majors will become Robert Noyce Scholars and receive funding for their junior and senior years.

- Must be enrolled in a UWF-Teach major as a junior or senior
- Must meet minimum GPA requirements and receive a minimum grade of C- in EDG20141 and EDF1005
- Submit two letters of recommendation
