

With the opening of this business, Argonaut Village is fully leased.



#### The UWF Police achieved accreditation from the Florida Commission for Law Enforcement.

Accreditation is the certification by an independent reviewing authority that an entity has met specific requirements and prescribed standards has long been recognized as a means of maintaining the highest standards of professionalism.

The UWF Police also achieved the Bronze level in the Lexipol Connect Recognition Program for 2022. Bronze level performance can be achieved by meeting the minimum required performance for four metrics: Average Hours of Training Assigned, Average Hours of Training Completed, User Activity and External Training Ratio.
