We are so excited to celebrate the 50th Anniversary of your graduation from the University of West Florida during the Golden Graduate Ceremony and Luncheon at the December 7, 2024 UWF Commencement Ceremony. It is our hope that this celebration will help you remember all of the great moments you had as a UWF student.

The ceremony and luncheon will be hosted at the Pensacola Bay Center, 201 E Gregory St., Pensacola, FL 32502. The ceremony will start at 9:30 a.m. with lunch immediately following the ceremony.

We have put together a list of frequently asked questions to help you prepare for the ceremony and luncheon.

Frequently Asked Questions:

Ceremony Details

Where do I park? In this packet, you received a parking pass that can be used to park in the front parking lot of the Pensacola Bay Center. Please see the map included in this packet. If we have your email address, an electronic version will also be sent to you to print.

Where do I report? Golden Graduates will report to the ground-level main entrance doors of the Pensacola Bay Center. You will then be directed to the designated meeting area right inside these doors. Bathrooms will be available in this area. Your guests will be seated in the VIP section of the arena.

When do I report? Golden Graduates will need to report by 8:45 a.m. to the meeting area on the ground floor of the Bay Center.

What do I wear? The dress for the event is business casual. The Pensacola Bay Center can be very cold due to ice down under the flooring of the arena for the Pensacola Ice Flyers hockey team. Wear comfortable shoes. Regalia (the traditional black graduation cap and gown) will be provided upon check-in and our staff will be available to assist you.

You will be provided with an embroidered gold stole and blue and green tassel to wear during the ceremony. The stole and tassel are gifts to you from your friends at the UWF Alumni Association.

What will happen at the ceremony? Golden Graduates will be fitted into their regalia and lined up in the meeting area. The group will then process into the arena and be seated with the rest of the graduates during the commencement ceremony.

Where do my guest(s) sit for the ceremony? All Golden Graduate guests will sit in VIP section 130 on the upper level. There will be staff and volunteers available to assist your guests in finding their seats.

One of my guests is handicapped. Is there ADA access to VIP section 130? Please let us know as soon as possible if a guest needs special seating accommodations. There will be access to an elevator on the ground floor and there is ADA seating close to section 130.

Golden Graduates Luncheon

Where is the luncheon held? The luncheon will be hosted at the Pensacola Bay Center on the 2nd floor. Golden Graduates will be escorted from the ceremony up to the luncheon.

How will my guests get to the luncheon? Guests seated in VIP section 130 will be escorted by volunteers to the 2nd floor luncheon location. <u>There may be a</u> delay in getting guests from the VIP section to the luncheon due to the volume of people in the arena and access to only one elevator.

What will happen at the luncheon? Golden Graduates and guests will be joined by UWF VIPs for a seated, 3-course lunch. UWF's President, Dr. Martha D. Saunders, will address the group.

What is the length of time for the luncheon? The luncheon will last between 60 and 90 minutes. Another commencement ceremony begins at 1:30 p.m.
