Behavior Technician Training

Our introductory Health Sciences Essentials of Behavior Analysis (HSC 3102) course meets the curriculum requirements for both the RBT and ABAT exams. Students passing either exam are qualified to work in the field of behavioral health.

Undergraduate ABA Certificate

Add our ABA certificate to your undergraduate degree. This six-course sequence meets curriculum requirements for both BCaBA and QASP-S exams.

Health Sciences, B.S.

The B.S. in Health Sciences with Specialization in Behavior Analysis includes all courses required to take the BCaBA and QASP-S certification exams.

Graduate ABA Certificates

Students who possess a master’s degree or are pursuing a graduate program at a different institution may enroll in one of our graduate certificates to meet the requirements for BCBA, IBA, or QBA certification exams. Additional graduate certificates are available for students who aim to specialize in Organizational Behavior Management or Research.

The M.S. in Behavior Science offers an engaging, cohort-based experience designed to build both research knowledge and professional expertise. Learn alongside dedicated peers and study with expert faculty and renowned scholars in the field. The core curriculum meets the coursework requirements for BCBA, IBA, or QBA certification exams. *Admission is limited to Fall semesters only.*

Exceptional Student Education, M.A.

The M.A. in Exceptional Student Education with a Specialization in ABA includes all courses required to take the BCBA certification exam. An extra three credit course is required to meet IBA exam requirements and QBA exam requirements can be met by choosing the appropriate electives.

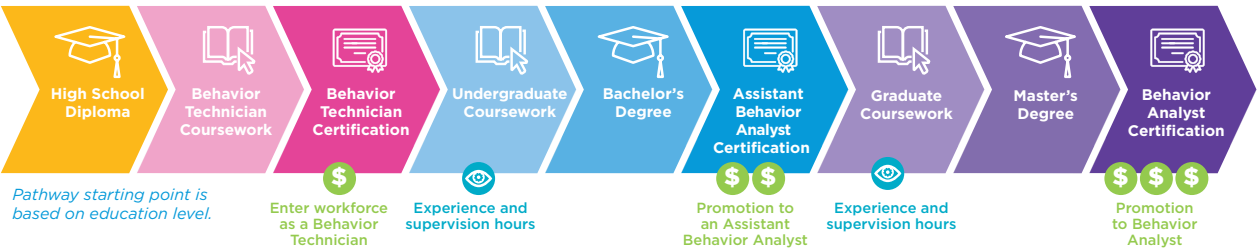
