

## **Explore Camps at Home! Online Code of Conduct and Best Practices**

Please take the time to review these guidelines with your child (if applicable) before the start of camp/class and ensure these guidelines are being followed at all times.

- Parents/guardians should supervise their children online, either directly or indirectly, subject to each child's age, maturity, and parental discretion.

- Treat an online setting like a face-to-face setting. Appropriate dress, language, and actions are required.

-Keep yourself on mute when not speaking. This will prevent others from hearing pets, siblings, or parents.

-Change your name to your first name only on Zoom calls.

-Instructors will go over basic camp rules at the start of camp about how to take turns speaking and sharing.

-For Ozobot camps that require some screen sharing from the campers computer, please make sure no other websites are open other than Zoom and Ozoblockly.

- Privacy is very important. Do not share personal information over the internet (i.e. name, address, phone number, age, passwords, etc.). Do not take screenshots, photos, or videos of anyone participating in Explore Camp At Home programs.

- Cyberbullying is not appropriate and will not be tolerated. Cyberbullying includes sending, posting, or sharing negative, harmful, false, or mean content about someone else. It can include sharing personal or private information about someone else causing embarrassment or humiliation. Consequences may include removal from the program.
