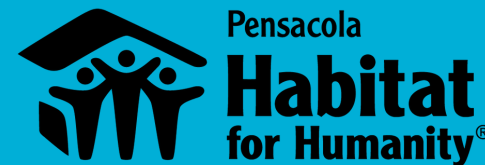

HOME PURCHASING PROGRAMS

Our **Homebuyer Program** offers affordable mortgages to qualified individuals and families in Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties. Approved homebuyers actively participate by contributing "sweat equity" hours, attending homebuyer education classes, and selecting from various housing options, including newly constructed and rehabilitated homes.

Established in 2023, the **Northwest Florida Community Land Trust (NFCLT)**, is a shared equity model designed to make homeownership attainable for low-income households. By separating land ownership from the home, the NFCLT ensures long-term affordability and stability. This home purchasing program is an alternative to renting.

Pensacola Habitat for Humanity offers **Open Market Housing** to provide additional quality, affordable homes for individuals and families in our community. These award-winning homes have specific income requirements but are not part of the traditional Homebuyer Program. Please note that Pensacola Habitat does not provide home financing for these homes; purchasing will require financing through a third-party lender of your choice.

COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT

Pensacola Habitat for Humanity's Community Development Program preserves homeownership for residents of Escambia and Santa Rosa Counties with incomes at or below 80% of the Area Median Income. The Community Development Program offers assistance programs for critical home repairs and other services that enhance quality of life.

HUD HOUSING COUNSELING

Clients work closely with our HUD-certified counselors to develop sustainable household budgets, credit improvement plans, and debt repayment strategies to prepare for homeownership. Our counselors also assist with foreclosure intervention, rental and eviction counseling, and disaster preparedness. We offer both one-on-one counseling and group education classes, including an 8-Hour Pre-Purchase Homebuyer Course.
