Junior IT Intern - American Magic

As a Junior IT Intern at American Magic, you will play a hands-on role in supporting the day-to-day technology needs of our high-performance sailing base. This position is ideal for someone eager to grow their skills in IT support, coding, and networking within a fast-paced, team-oriented environment.

Key Responsibilities

- Provide first-level IT support to ensure smooth daily operations at the base (e.g., troubleshooting internet issues, fixing printers, repairing or installing cabling, etc.).
- Assist in the development of automation and integration workflows using Google Workspace tools (e.g., Apps Script, Google Sheets, Forms, and Gmail APIs).
- Help create and maintain internal tools and automated systems for onboarding/offboarding, purchase orders, inventory management, base access, and timesheets.
- Support setup and basic maintenance of networking infrastructure, especially systems based on UniFi equipment.
- Monitor network performance and assist in diagnosing connectivity or configuration issues.
- Collaborate with cross-functional teams to understand operational needs and implement tech-based solutions.
- Document processes, configurations, and IT support activities to support long-term system stability and onboarding of future IT team members.

Preferred Skills:

- Basic understanding of networking principles (IP addressing, DHCP, DNS, firewalls, etc.).
- Experience with or willingness to learn Google Apps Script and related APIs.
- Strong troubleshooting skills and a proactive approach to identifying and solving issues.
- Familiarity with UniFi networking equipment is a plus but not required.
- Ability to manage multiple tasks and prioritize effectively in a fast-moving environment.
- Clear communication and a team-first mindset.
