Quality Engineering Specialist Job Description

This position is responsible for processing information on documents required to assist engineering, production, quality, and program management. This person will maintain effective relationships and interact within a positive and productive work environment within the company.

Responsibilities

- Prepare master data for ERP database, assist with implementation of cost point database software.
- In-process and visual inspections on shop floor daily.
- Participation in internal AS9100 audits.
- Working with quality management, maintains company ASL (Approved Supplier List) supplier records, scorecards, registrar certificate, etc.
- Implementation and development of internal KPI's.
- Compliance and Configuration Management – Compliance of industry standards and internal configuration management maintenance.
- Participation in maintaining, creating, and editing internal processes and procedures.
- Investigate and closeout of SCARs and NCRs/QNs.
- Perform dimensional inspections as needed in Final, WIP and Receiving.
